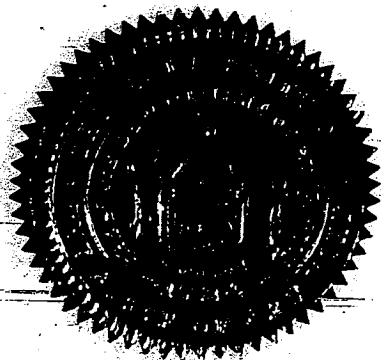

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

of

INTER-DEMOCRACY FEDERAL UNIONISTS, INC.

- Pursuant to Article II of the
Membership Corporation Law

WE, the undersigned, for the purpose of forming a membership corporation, pursuant to Article II of the Membership Corporation Law of the State of New York, DO HEREBY CERTIFY:

FIRST: The name of the proposed Corporation is Inter-Democracy Federal Unionists, Inc.

SECOND: The purpose for which the Corporation is to be formed is to promote education in the basic principles of federal union as exemplified in the Constitution of the United States, with a view to attaining world order by a Federal Union of Democratic Peoples.

THIRD: The Corporation shall have power to do each and every thing that may be necessary or convenient to accomplish the purpose stated above, including the following:

- (a) To acquire real and personal property by purchase, lease, devise, bequest, or gift; to take, own, hold, mortgage or otherwise encumber, and to lease, sell, exchange, transfer or in any manner whatever dispose of such property within or without the State of New York.
- (b) To publish and issue books, reports, periodicals, pamphlets, and phonograph records; conduct lectures, discussions and debates; disseminate information, and otherwise educate and instruct the general public in the principles of a Federal Union Government.
- (c) To establish, maintain, control, and close or otherwise terminate branch offices and local committees within and without the State of New York, without restriction as to place or number.

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FOURTH: The Corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for educational purposes and purposes of public benevolence, and not for pecuniary profit. No part of its income or funds whatsoever shall inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member of the Corporation, nor shall any director, officer, or member receive or be lawfully entitled to receive any pecuniary profit from the operations thereof, except reasonable compensation for services rendered in carrying out its purpose.

FIFTH: The territory in which its operations are principally to be conducted is the United States of America and the territories and possessions of the United States of America.

SIXTH: The principal office of the Corporation is to be located in the Borough of Manhattan, City, County and State of New York.

SEVENTH: The number of its directors shall be not less than three, and not more than thirty.
